Davitt Cunningham's success story began at an early age. A combination of natural ability and hard work made he was featured in Swimmer's World Magazine and by the time he was a Freshman (age 15), he was ranked years as a Varsity swimmer, Davitt never lost a race. By the time he graduated, Davitt owned every swim record for the 100 Freestyle, and held the EBAL record in that event until this year. Davitt was named Junior and Senior years and was named the Most Outstanding Athlete in the 7 Bay Area Counties in 1979.
