Kristine Sue Pigeon or Kristy to those who know her best began playing tennis as a young girl. Ever since the is one of the reasons she is honored.

Kristy attended San Ramon Valley High School at a time when there was no girl's tennis team in existence. T however – she was making a name for herself as a state champion, national champion and world champion.

While a student at San Ramon, Kristy dazzled the tennis world with her athletic prowess and in 1966 won the Under-Singles. In 1968, Kristy racked up numerous championships winning the California State Championshi Girls Singles & Doubles Championships; and the Wimbledon Junior Singles Championship for Girls under 21

Upon graduation from SRVHS, Kristy went on to attend Mills College and UC Berkeley, but did not play colleg 1969.

As a professional tennis player, Kristy was an original member of the Virginia Slims Tournament Players and Women Pros. Kristy played on the winning U.S. Wightman Cup Team, played World Team Tennis for Hawaii I including the U.S., Caribbean, European, and South African.

From 1976 to 1989, Miss Pigeon owned and operated the Elkhorn Tennis School in Sun Valley, Idaho. In 199 multipurpose equestrian facility in Idaho. There she developed a nonprofit organization to provide equine assi mentally, and emotionally impaired children and adults.
