Robby Smith – Class of 2005 - Wrestling

Robby is synonymous with world class wrestling. At San Ramon, he was a four-year letterman. He was EBA NCS Champion in 3 of his four years and placed at the State meet, also in three of his four years!

Robby attended Northern Michigan University. After Northern Michigan, he was asked to come to the Olympics competed at 96 kg for 8 years. He went to 130kg in 2012 and has been competing at this level ever since. Robby is a 2016 Olympic team member Pan-American champion 2015 and third in the Pan-American games 2015 two-time World Champion 2013 and 2015

Robby is still competing on the international stage. Some of his career highlights to date are:

2016 U. S. Olympic Team member and U.S. Trial Champion

Two-time World Championships, 5th place

Three-time U.S. World Team member

Two-time US. Open champion

2015 Pan American Games bronze medalist
