ATHLETICS

BUS TRANSPORTATION

COLLEGE & CAREER CENTER

<u>CLUBS</u>

There are more than 100 student-led clubs to get involved in at SRVHS. The list of this year's clubs is posted on the SRVHS website under the <u>Student Activities</u> tab. Our annual Club Fair occurs in early September. Club meetings usually take place during lunch.

COMPUTER ACCESS

COUNSELING

All students are assigned to a counselor based on their last name. Students may walk in to visit their counselor during brunch and lunch, as well as before and after school. Students can also email their counselor directly or request an appointment using a Google form. Visit the <u>Counseling page</u> of the SRVHS website to find Google appointment form as well as the counselor's email address under each counselor's picture. The counselor will send a pass for the student when appropriate. Counselors are happy to help with academic, college, and career questions, as well as any personal concerns students may have.

ID CARDS

SRV Students need an ID card to check out textbooks, library books, and get into San Ramon events. (You must show your ID to attend sporting events.) ASB Activity Seals are available for purchase during Wolf Pack Day or through the SRVHS Web store. If you lose your ID card, see the Financial Analyst in the Attendance office to purchase a replacement card.

INFINITE CAMPUS PORTAL

Every parent should establish a Campus portal account in Infinite Campus. Annual update is done every year to update important emergency contacts, releases and other demographic information. Student's grades/transcripts are posted on the campus portal under documents. You can access the Infinite Campus portal from the front page of the <u>SRVHS website</u> under QuickLinks. <u>LIBRARY</u>

Students need an ID and student number to check out a book. This may be your SRVHS ID, Driver's License, or other ID card with your picture and name. The <u>SRVHS library</u> is open Monday through Friday, 8:00am -3:30pm. The library is also open at brunch and lunch for computer use, book checkout, and studying.

LOCKERS

Lockers are available for use on campus. Visit the Counseling office for help with lockers.

LUNCH and BRUNCH

The lunch menu includes a variety of hot and cold entrées, along with fresh fruit, vegetables, and milk. Breakfast and lunch are provided free to all students. Students may eat in the Commons or outdoors. We are still encouraging families to continue to complete the Education Benefit Form (formerly Meal Application) because it could provide additional money and services for their family and the school district. NAVIANCE STUDENT

Naviance Student is a web-based service designed for planning and exploring career and/or college options. The comprehensive Naviance site allows students and parents to research and make decisions about courses, careers and colleges. The site is also used to post upcoming college visits, scholarship information, and summer enrichment. The counseling department and College & Career Center help students create their Naviance account in 9th grade and continue to teach students Naviance skills in grades 10-12. PARKING PERMITS

Parking in the student lot is by permit only. All senior and junior students who wish to apply for a parking permit must complete an application. Information will be posted on the website under <u>Student Activities</u>. Students and their parent/guardian must attend one free two hour CHP Start Smart class in order to be eligible for a parking permit at all SRVUSD High Schools.

PE CLOTHES

Students are required to change for PE. Click the <u>Webstore tile</u> on the front page of the website to make your purchase. There is a suggested donation for items - pick up your items at Wolf Pack Day or from your PE teacher. PE lockers will be assigned by teachers.

<u>SCHOOLOGY</u>

SRVHS uses Schoology, an online program to help parents, students, and teachers stay up-to-date on academic performance. Schoology should be used as a reference only, not the only means of gathering information from teachers. The link to Schoology is located at the top of the front page of the <u>SRVHS Website</u>. Schoology uses the same parent email listed in Infinite Campus. **Students and parents should both register for this service and maintain separate accounts**.

SCHOOL PHOTOS

School Photos are taken at Wolf Pack Day. Photo packets are available for purchase at that time. These photos are used for ID cards and will go into the yearbook for 9th-11th grade students. If you are not able to attend Wolfpack Day, there will be a make-up picture day in September. Senior photos are taken by Studio One Photography. Call (925)361-0430 for details.

SPIRITWEAR

Spirit wear is sold to the SRV community by many of our clubs and booster groups. Items are sold at Wolf Pack Day, at school during lunchtime and at some sporting events. You can also place an order in the <u>SRV Sideline Store</u> under Athletics on the SRVHS website.

SRVHS WEBSITE

TEXTBOOKS

Student ID is required to check out textbooks. If a student checks out a textbook from the Textbook Office, they will be held responsible if the textbook is lost or damaged. ALL textbooks are barcoded. Your student is responsible for returning the book with the barcode that was checked out to them. If the book is lost, it will need to be paid for. All textbooks that are checked out from the Textbook Office need to be returned directly to the Textbook Office, not the teacher.
